2021 ASHA Virtual Spring Tune Up Show

Riding Classes:

Leadline and Walk/Trot/Jog (English/Western) - Junior and Senior Divisions

- 1. No cross entry between Walk Trot (WT) and Walk Trot Canter (WTC) for the same horse/rider pair. A horse can be in the WT and WTC with different riders.
- 2. Leadline is for kids 10 years old and under that are not riding on their own yet. They must wear a helmet and boots.
- 3. Martingales are allowed in Walk Trot Jog classes only.
- 4. The horse should show a Walk Trot (WT) and/or Walk Jog (WJ) in both directions with approximately 30 seconds in each gait for the WT and TJ classes.

Pleasure Classes (English/Western) - Junior and Senior Divisions

- 1. The pleasure classes should be simulated like a pleasure class at a show. The horse should show all gaits in both directions with approximately 30 seconds in each gait, which includes Walk Trot Canter, Extended Trot and Canter/Lope should also be shown in both directions. At the end of all pleasure classes, line up center ring, stand quietly, back your horse 3 to 4 steps and return to line up.
- 2. For the dressage classes, the dressage tests of choice will be posted on our group Facebook page. Your score sheet will be available online.
- 3. English classes may be performed in any English type saddle.
- 4. Dressage (English/Western) suitability may be performed in a close contact, dressage saddle, western saddle or saddle seat type saddle.
- 5. Attire to be appropriate for style of riding. Approved protective headgear optional. Headgear to be appropriate for style of riding.
- 6. Appropriate footwear must be worn.
- 7. It is recommended gloves be worn.
- 8. Western classes should be performed in a western or trail saddle.

Driving (Two or Four Wheel)

1. Driving classes should show a Walk, Trot and Extended Trot in both directions. At the end, line up center ring, stand quietly, back up your horse 3 to 4 steps, and return to line up. Headers are allowed.

2. Drivers will be judged on neatness of attire. Helmets optional.

Dressage Classes:

Tests - Junior and Senior Divisions

- Lead Line (10 years old and under)
- Walk Trot Jr. (Test A, B, C)
- Walk Trot Sr. (Test A, B, C)
- Training Level English (Test A, B, C)
- Training Level Western (Test A, B, C)
- First Level English (Test A, B, C)
- First Level Western (Test A, B, C)

Ring

- All levels can use a 20x40 or 20x60 ring.
- Ring must have letters OR markers in place of letters.
- Rails and defined corners are encouraged.

Dress

- Turnout, neat and tidy. Attire to be appropriate for style of riding.
- Show attire and braiding (English dressage) is encouraged but not mandatory.

Video Submissions:

- Caller or videographer must announce the rider, horse, date, and test ridden (this is to avoid cross-posting the same video for multiple shows).
- All videos must be continuous no editing allowed.
- Helmet to hoof must be in frame at all times.
- For Dressage Tests, continue filming until the final salute for Dressage Tests and for Pleasure Classes, until the horse and rider have backed their horse and are standing quietly.
- In general, try to clearly capture each movement as best as possible.
- For Dressage Tests, callers are permitted. Videographer and caller may be the same person.
- For Dressage Classes, video to be taken at C position. For all other classes, video can be taken anywhere suitable to capture the rider's class.

- All video submissions will be posted to the Facebook page to simulate (as much as possible) a genuine show experience. Videos will be posted after results have been posted.
- Videos must be uploaded to YouTube. Entry form will include a line to attach your YouTube link/links.
- It is helpful to elevate the camera on a tripod to keep it steady. Zooming in is acceptable as long as helmet to hoof are always in the frame. Following along the sides of the ring and into the corners are recommended/encouraged for Dressage Classes.

^{*}Please note, how you choose to set up and film your ring may affect how movements are perceived. It's better to give the judge a test with movements that can be clearly rather than throw marks away because the judge couldn't see a movement.
